Team Competition

Team play is highly encouraged at HOTO Sertoma Oktoberfest 2016. The top team in each "team event" will receive awards, as well as the top three (3) overall team finishers. Teams will consist of four (4) members (2 men and 2 women). The competition will be team competition. There will be total of six (6) team events, as listed below.

Once all events are completed, the total scores from each event will be combined to determine a final team score. The three teams with the highest combined scores will be awarded overall prizes. The top team will have their name memorialized on the Festzelt Trophy.

Team Attire

- Each Team will represent a country. For simply dressing alike, teams will be awarded 5 points.
- Tennis Shoes are REQUIRED to participate. We highly encourage people to bring their own gloves as well.

Scoring

Points will be awarded based on how the team placed in each competition. Each event has different judging criteria, and the applicable rules must be followed to be awarded any points.

1 st Place:	10 Points
2 nd Place:	8 Points
3 rd Place:	6 Points
4 th Place:	5 Points
5 th Place:	4 Points
6 th Place:	3 Points
7 th Place:	2 Points
8 th Place:	1 Points

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Team Events

Fassroll – "Barrel Rolling"

Barrel Rolling is one of the oldest games that is a tradition of Oktoberfest. The game will be a test of agility and speed, to see which team can complete the Barrel Rolling Course the fastest. This will be a relay, so each member of the team has to roll the barrel part of the way on the course to the next member. The rules are simple: push the barrel through the course, and the overall fastest team time wins. The top 8 teams will be awarded points toward the overall competition.

Fass Toss – "Keg Toss"

The Keg Toss challenge is a test of strength, to see how far each team member can toss the keg. How you toss it is up to you. However, you cannot cross the starting circle, and must stay within the marked boundary. Each member of the team must toss the keg, and the individual team member distances will be combined into an overall team score. The top 8 teams with the longest distance will be awarded points toward the overall competition.

Ziehen Des Fasses – "Pulling of the Kegs"

This is a contest of strength, whereby teams will pull a sled 50 feet, with 5 (empty) beer kegs on it, by a rope. The only catch is that your heaviest teammate must also be on the keg sled when the other 3 pull them and the empty beer kegs on the sled. There will be a time limit of 5 minutes to complete this task. The top 8 teams with the fastest times will be awarded points for the overall competition.

Dreirad Herausforderung – "Keg-Trike Challenge"

The "Dreirad Herausforderung" is a tricycle relay race, where a team of four (4) members must complete a timed relay. Each team member must complete one lap. This is a combined time event, with the top 8 fastest teams being awarded points for overall competition.

Hammerschlaggen – "Hammer the Spike"

The Hammer the Spike challenge is a test of speed, strength, and focus, to see which team can hammer a spike into a log the fastest. This is a team event where each member is given a hammer, and with one hand behind their back, they must take alternating hits on the spike. The team member may not rest the hammer on the spike before the swing, or double hit the spike in one swing. Each occurrence of a violation shall result in a 5 second penalty to the team's time. The top 8 teams will be award points toward the overall competition.

Ziehen das Seil – "Tug-O-War"

Tug-O-War is a team even that is a test of raw strength and leverage, in which teams are paired against each other in a double-elimination tournament. Two teams are lined up an equal distance from the middle line. Both teams hold a rope, and attempt to pull the opposing team across the middle line. The competition ends when any part of any member of the team crosses the middle line. The top teams will be awarded points toward the overall competition. Points will be determined based on the number of teams competing.
